- Munros The 282 Scottish mountains over 3000ft as listed by the SMC.
- Tops The 226 subsidiary Scottish summits over 3000ft as listed by the SMC.
- Furths The 34 summits over 3000ft in England, Wales and Ireland as listed by the SMC.
- Corbetts The 222 Scottish mountains ≥ 2500 ft and < 3000 ft (with 500ft of 'prominence') as listed by the SMC.
- Grahams The 219 Scottish mountains ≥ 2000 ft and < 2500 ft (with 500ft of 'prominence').
- Marilyns The 1555 summits in Scotland, England, Wales and the Isle of Man with 150m of 'prominence'.

The Marilyns include all the Grahams and Corbetts, 203 Munros and 9 Furths.

The lists occasionally change but a completion is considered valid if it includes all the hills on the list at the time of completion.
